


A Survivor of Munich '72 comes to tell his story at Chabad

Dan Alon, one of the five survivors of the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre, began fencing when he was 12. At 27, he marched proudly into the 1972 Munich Olympics to compete for his country with fifteen fellow Israeli athletes. On September 5 at 4:30am, Alon awoke to the sound of machine guns: the Palestinian terrorist group Black September had invaded their suite in Olympic Village and seized 11 of the athletes as hostages. None survived.
